Father's Day in Japan

Father's Day is called Chichi No Hi (ちちのひ), with 'chichi' meaning 'father', 'no' meaning "s" and 'hi' meaning 'day'.

The Japanese version of this holiday is similar to Australian version. Father's Day is a time to let your father (or father-figure) know how much he means to you.

The date of Father's Day is the third Sunday of June, which is different from Australian Father's Day.

On Father's Day, people celebrate and show thankfulness toward fathers. This is same to Australia.
